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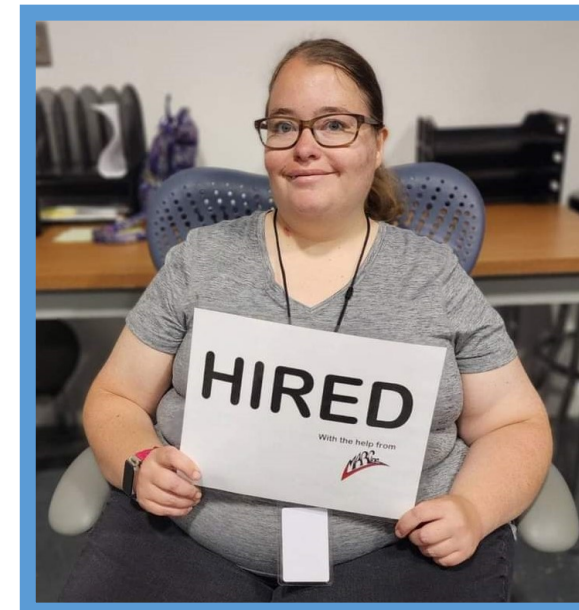
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Who Are We?

Our program allows each intern with a disability to be immersed in a workplace setting giving hands on experience that will increase their skills and abilities. These skills and abilities will enhance their chances at competitive work and reaching their employment goals.

Benefits for Students & Families:

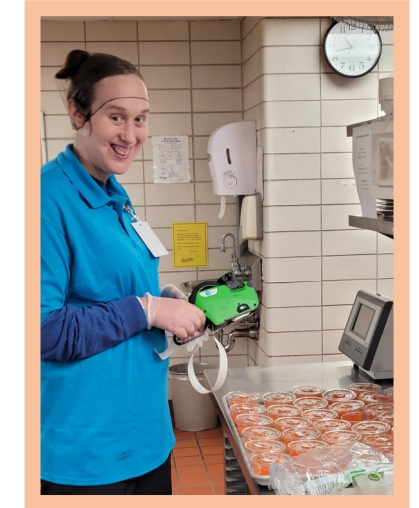
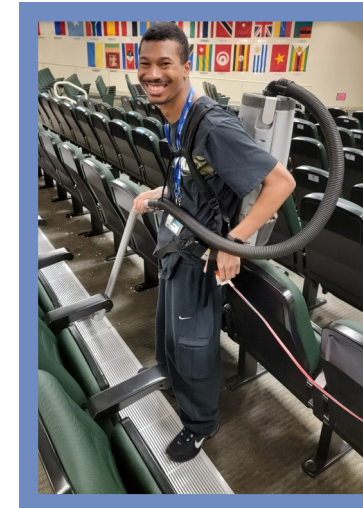
